

Summer One Term 2016 First Half

We hope that this overview of this half term's topics will provide you with ideas of how to help your child with their learning.

This half term our main topic will be: 'Traditional tales.'

Literacy

We will be learning about many of our favourite traditional tales and covering a wide range of activities.

You can help at home by:

- Reading traditional tales (e.g. Cinderella, Little Red Riding Hood, Three Little Pigs, The Three Billy Goats Gruff, Jack and the Beanstalk and many others).
- Encouraging your child to talk about the stories What is their favourite part? Who is their favourite character and why? Can they retell the story by using the pictures!
- Visiting the library to look for traditional stories perhaps you might find an alternative version of the story!

To help with reading and writing:

- Read with your child every day and discuss the story and asking questions.
- Practise correct letter formation.

- Build sentences using key words, and write them using a capital letter and full stop.
- Help your children with their weekly phonics homework.

Science

We will be learning about a variety of plants and seasonal changes. We will also be learning about living things and their habitats.

Art

We will be exploring African art. We will learn about the artist Picasso and how African art influenced him.

Design Technology.

We will be investigating different biscuits, shapes and flavours. We will design, make and evaluate a biscuit.

Computing.

We will be using the computer to create character profiles for some of our favourite characters from traditional tales. The children will also be using word banks to create sentences linked to our topic as well as using the internet to find out and research different artists.
