Operation Encompass Letter to Parents

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you that the school takes part in a jointly run operation between West Midlands Police and our school, which is known as Operation Encompass.

Operation Encompass has been set-up to help schools to provide support to children who have been present, or exposed to or involved in any domestic abuse incident. We know that children can be significantly physically or emotionally harmed when they witness or are involved, directly or indirectly, with any domestic abuse incident.

The school will receive a confidential email from West Midlands Police on the morning after a child or young person has exposed to, or involved in, any domestic incident.

At Amblecote Primary we have eight designated safeguarding staff: myself, Mrs Pickett, Mrs Bradley, Mrs Price, Miss Careless, Miss O'Connor, Mrs Dunckley and Mrs Sparrow. We have been trained to allow us to use the information that has been shared, in confidence, while ensuring that the school is able to make provision for the right support to be available to ensure the wellbeing of any child and their family.

We are always keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we know this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.
